

YouTube Competition Guidelines

1. This competition is open to schools, families, individuals and out of school clubs.
2. The video clip should show what it means to you to be gifted in today's society.
3. The video clip must be between 2-3 minutes long.
4. It must contain the four line wording:
It's alright to be bright
It's cool to be clever
We've all got potential
Let's celebrate together.
5. You can choose to write a song, act out a play or however you can best convey your message.
6. It must conform to all YouTube rules and terms of use, including video content and formatting for uploading. The clip should not be offensive in any way or contain adult content. Please see YouTube Handbook at www.youtube.com for further details.
7. As the person producing the video clip, it is your responsibility to ensure you have the parental permission for anyone featured in it and that they have been explicitly told their child will feature in a video clip on YouTube. Please confirm that you have done this when you submit your competition entry to NAGC.
8. Judges will be looking for originality, humour and universal appeal.
9. Once you have made your clip please email it to itsalrighttobebright@nagcbrtain.org.uk, with your clip title and a short description about the clip, which can then be uploaded to our account and entered into the competition. Don't forget to send us your contact details so we can notify you if you win.
10. NAGC cannot accept liability for anyone who appears in the clip without their explicit consent or consent from their parent/guardian. NAGC reserves the right to remove the video clip at any time.
11. Closing date for entries is: Friday 9th October 2009 at midday.
12. Competition winners will be announced at NAGC's AGM on Sunday 25th October 2009.
13. All winners will be notified by 31st October 2009.
